

## INDICATORS OF PROGRESS USED FOR GPRA MEASURES

**8.1LT and 8A:** Increase the percentage of individuals with developmental disabilities reached by the Councils who are independent, self-sufficient and integrated into the community by one tenth percent each year beginning in FY 2010 through FY 2014.<sup>1</sup> (*Outcome*)

**8E:** Increase the number of individuals with developmental disabilities reached by the Councils who are independent, self-sufficient and integrated into the community per \$1,000 of federal funding to the Councils.<sup>2</sup> (*Efficiency*)
