



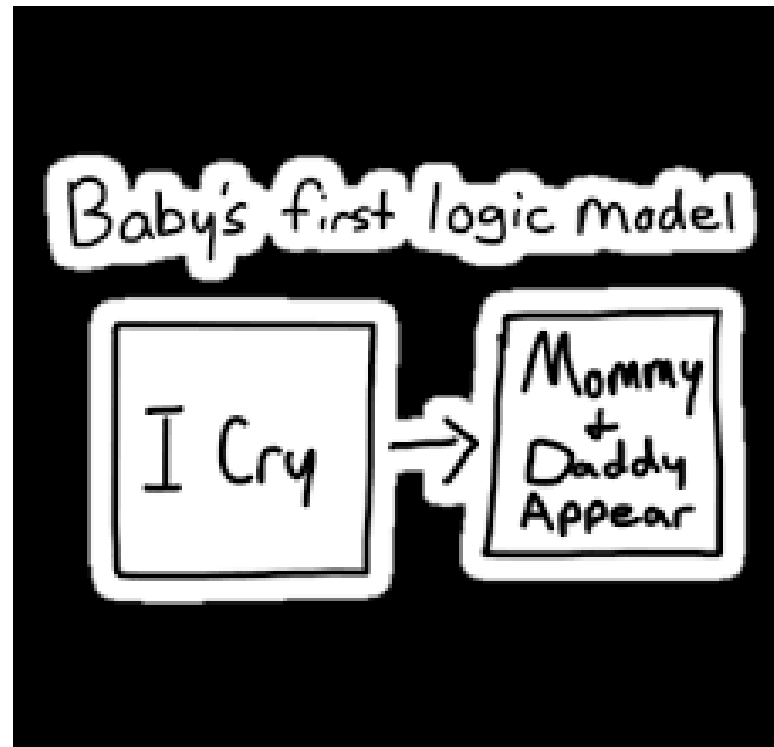

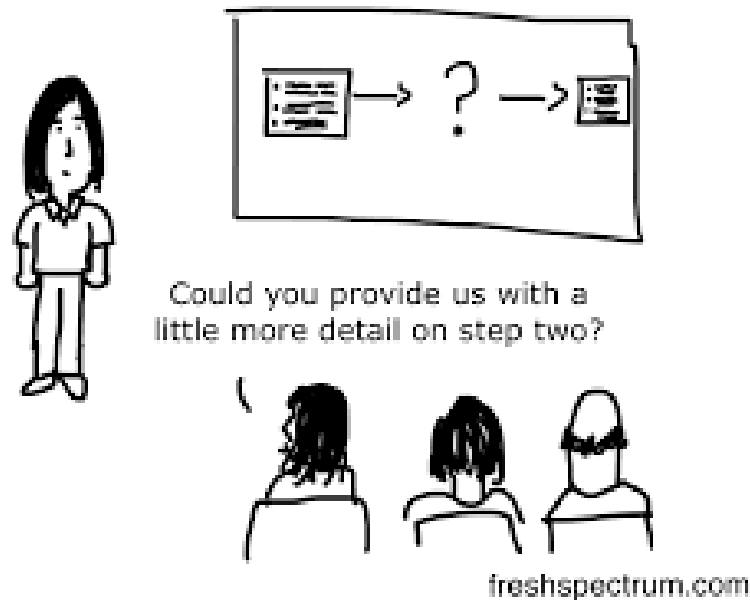

The Simple View



2017-2021 5-Year State Plan Template

- The revised template requires the DD Council to submit a logic model for the 5-year plan



Template guidance

- Develop a 5 year logic model that presents the logical connections between DD Council activities and desired DD Council outcomes.
- The logic model should reflect an understanding of the relationships among the resources a DD Council has to operate, the strategies/activities the DD Council plans to implement, and the outputs and outcomes the DD Council expects to achieve.

What is a logic model?

- A diagram (and words) that shows key relationships among program elements
- A diagram that shows a direct relationship between activities and outputs and impact
- A diagram that helps people clearly see “what the DD Council does” versus “what the DD Council is trying to achieve”
- A diagram that shows the links in a chain of reasoning (“what causes what”)

Logic Model Basics

- Process Components
 - Inputs
 - Strategies/Activities
 - Outputs
- Outcome Components
 - Short-term outcomes
 - Intermediate outcomes
 - Long term outcomes

Basic diagram



Inputs, activities, and outputs correspond to the actions you plan for your DD Council

Outcomes (short-term, intermediate, and long-term) and impact illustrate what you expect to achieve through the actions.

Basic diagram expanded



Resources the DD Council uses to support activities.

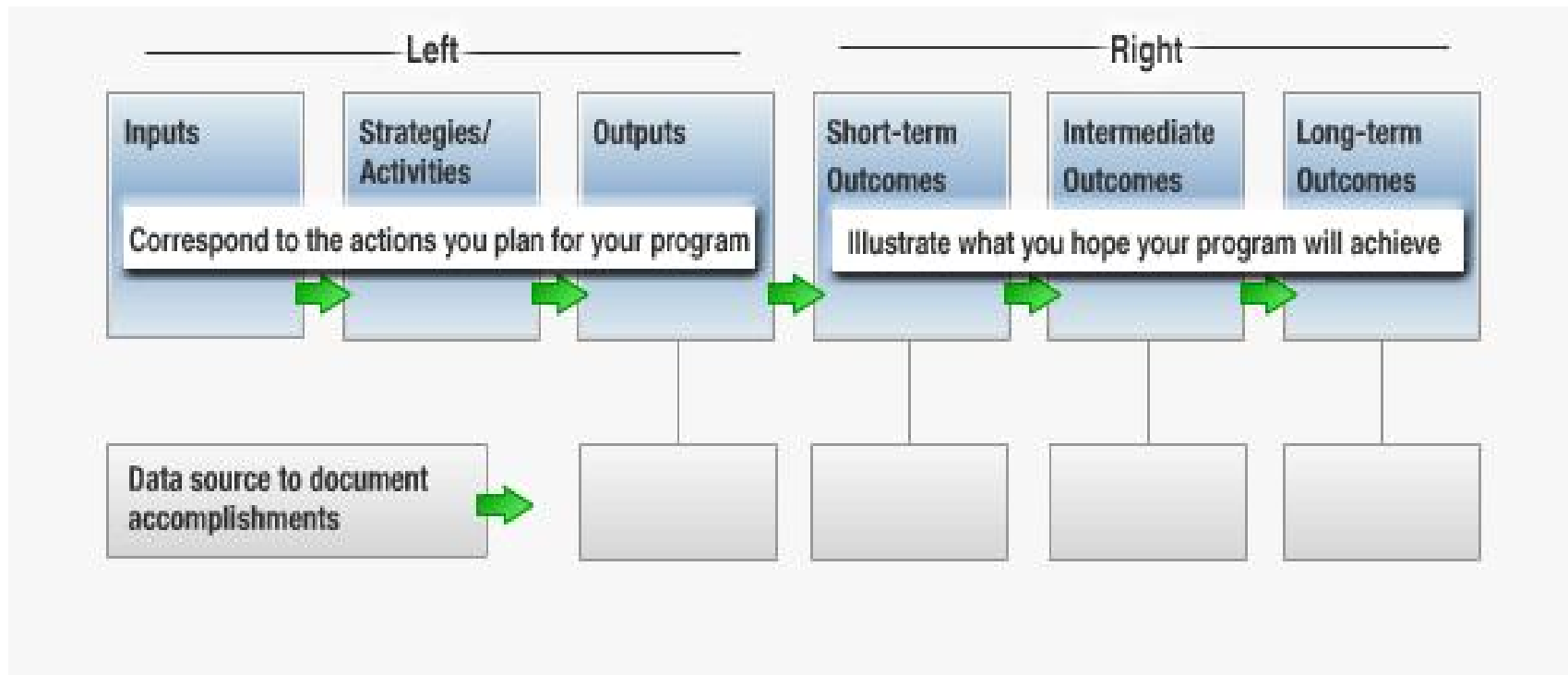
Specific things the DD Council has planned related to the goal(s).

Products or deliverables the DD Council intends to provide; measured by count or other data; can include who the DD Council expects to reach related to the goal

The intended outcomes or specific changes that are a direct result of the implementation activities; often represented as short-term (1-3 years), intermediate-term (3-5 years), or long-term (4-7 years)

The overall purpose of the goal stated in terms of changes related to the goal.

Final thoughts

- A logic model helps guide the work by charting a road map for your work.
- Because the logic model reflects the DD Council work, it is important that the logic model align with the 5-year plan goals and strategies and activities that are identified in the plan.
- In turn, the 5-year strategic plan and logic model should guide the objectives and activities for implementing strategies/activities selected and described in the annual work plan.
- To ensure their usefulness as planning tools, periodically review and compare the 5-year plan, logic model, and work plan, especially when writing your annual work plan(s).
