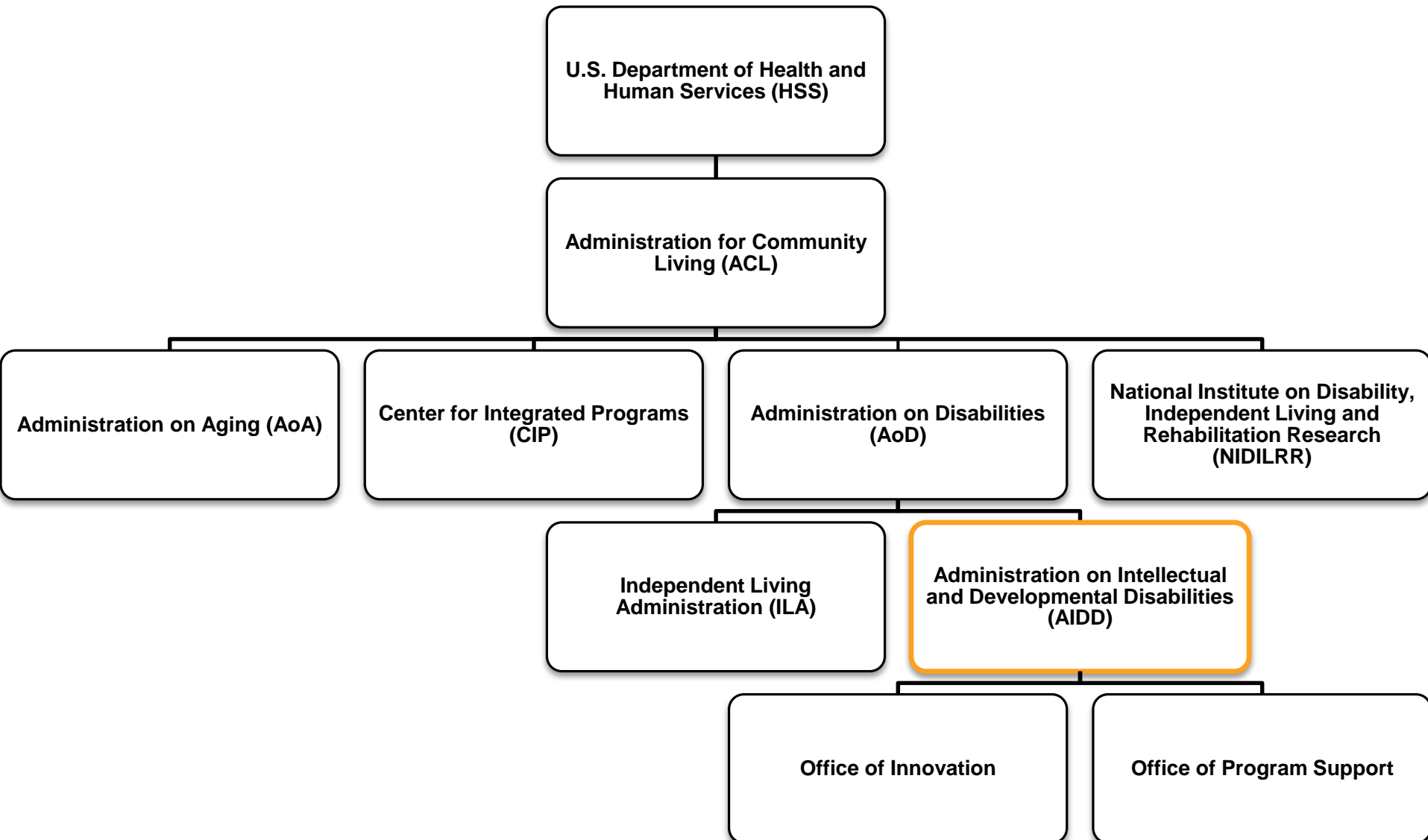

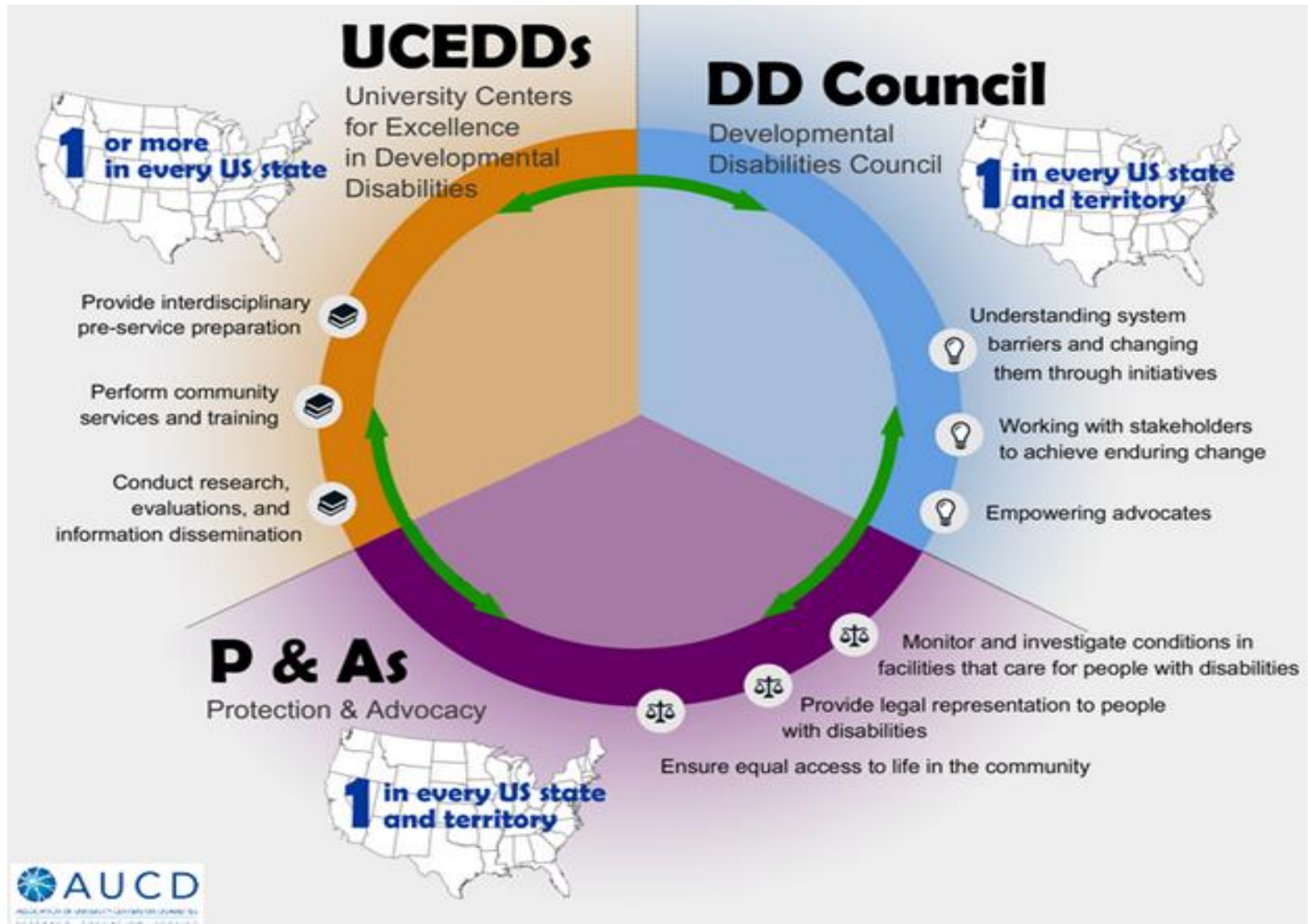

- NACDD is the national membership organization for State/Territory Councils on Developmental Disabilities.
- NACDD serves as the national voice of State and Territorial Councils on Developmental Disabilities. NACDD supports DD Councils in implementing the Developmental Disabilities Assistance and Bill of Rights Act promoting the interest and rights of people with developmental disabilities and their families.

Technical Assistance (TA) for DD Councils

- The DD Act mandates technical assistance be made available to all Councils on Developmental Disabilities.
- NACDD received the award to provide technical assistance to Councils on Developmental Disabilities through a federal grant from the Administration for Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities (AIDD).
- ITACC provides TA services to Councils
