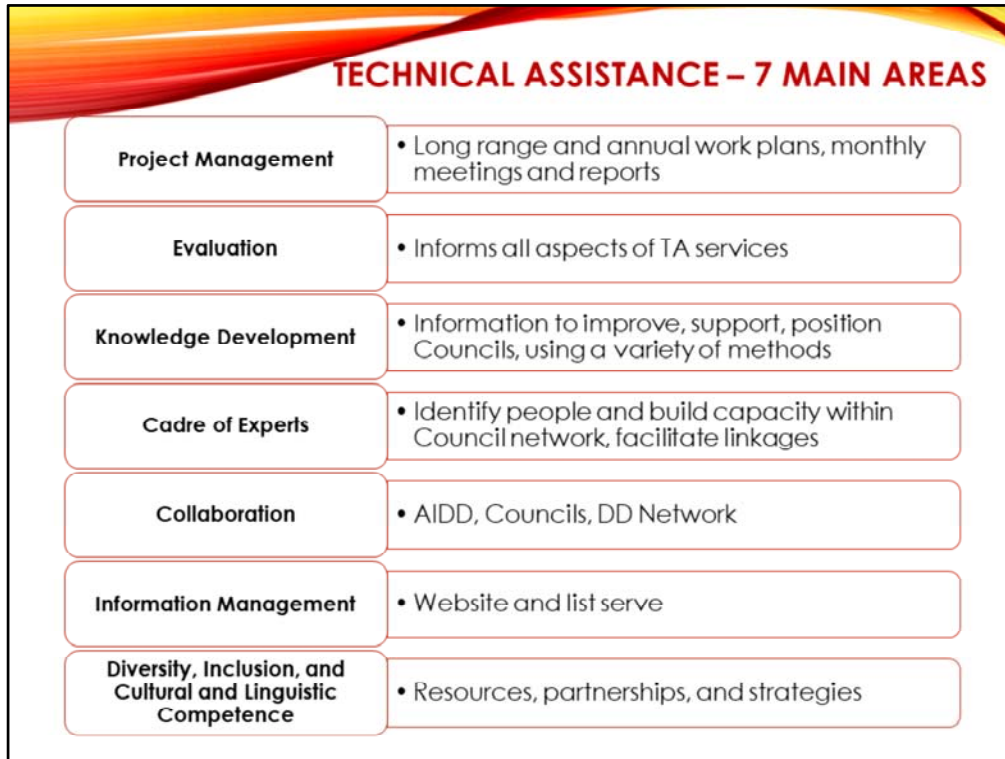




RESULTS, RESOURCES, AND NEEDS

TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE - PURPOSE

Improve	Improve Council performance, operations, and outcomes;
Assist	Assist Councils with maintaining statutory compliance;
Position	Position Councils as leaders and catalysts of systems change, capacity building, and advocacy



The Technical Assistance contract includes 7 main areas (objectives) and include project management – this includes our 5 year plan, annual work plans, monthly reports and meetings

Evaluation – we developed a long-range plan that is updated annually and we evaluate all aspects of TA services

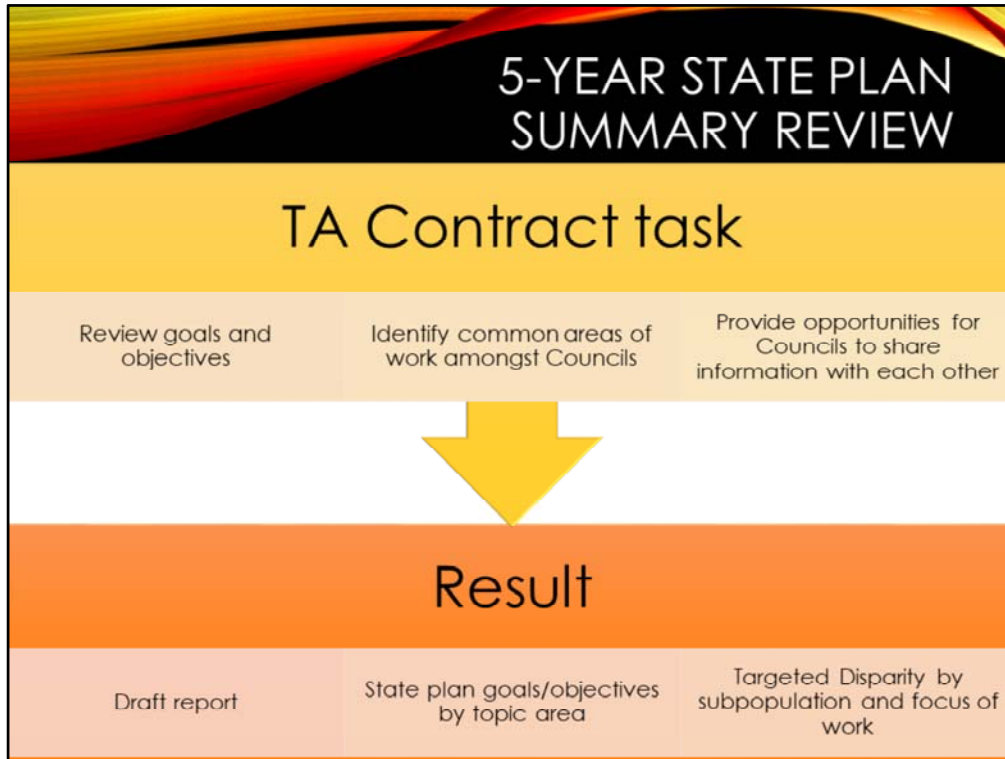
Knowledge development – TAI, New ED Orientation, Chair training, Field notes, list-serves, webinars, guidance documents

Cadre of Experts – this task is our Knowledge, Skills, and Experience Listing – we update annually – all ED’s have a copy and the full listing can be obtained by contacting Angela or me.

Collaboration activities include collaboration with AIDD, DD Councils, and the DD Network – we meet regularly with the other partner TA providers

Information management is a core area for providing information to the DD Council network – the website and list-serves are primary methods of communication

And Diversity, Inclusion, and Cultural and Linguistic Competence – activities center around resources, partnerships, and strategies to assist Councils with their work.



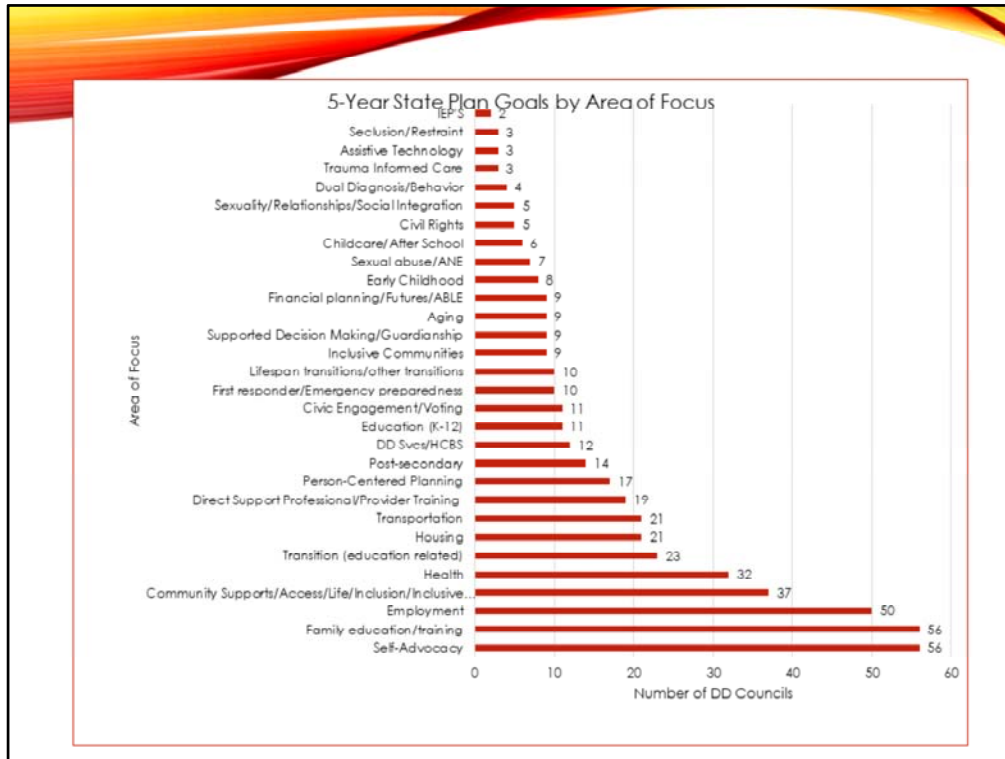
We'd like to highlight the 5 year State plan summary review – a core task during this fiscal year was to review all goals and objectives of individual Council plans, identify common areas of work among Councils, and provide opportunities for Councils to share information with each other –

The result is a draft report – you have a handout that of the summary – with some charts – the charts reflect focus areas (or topics) Councils planned to work; and also, specific information on the targeted disparity element by subpopulation and focus of work.

The full document is 140 pages – and will be posted to the itacchelp.org website after it is finalized. The document has all individual Council goals and objectives reflected – that way, if you want to see what another Council planned, you will have access to the information in one document.

Let's take a look -

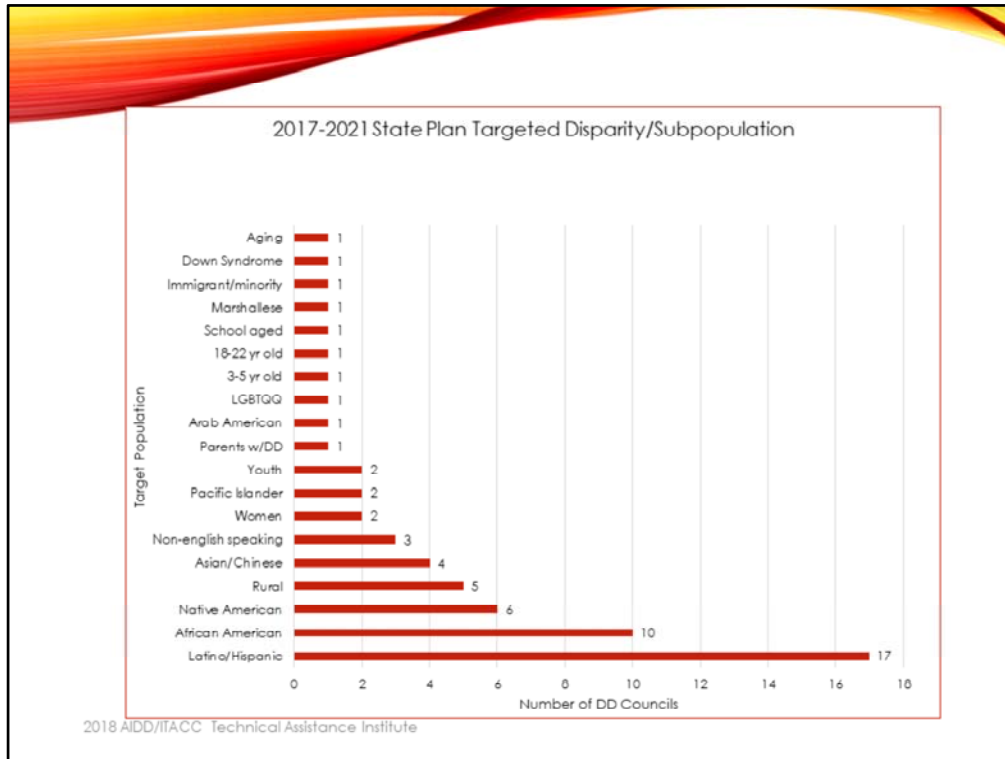


We highlighted 29 topics that multiple Councils planned to work. As you know, Council plans are individualized, so some of your specific areas of focus may not be listed.

For the items on this chart, there is a table that lists the Councils who included these activities in their plans.

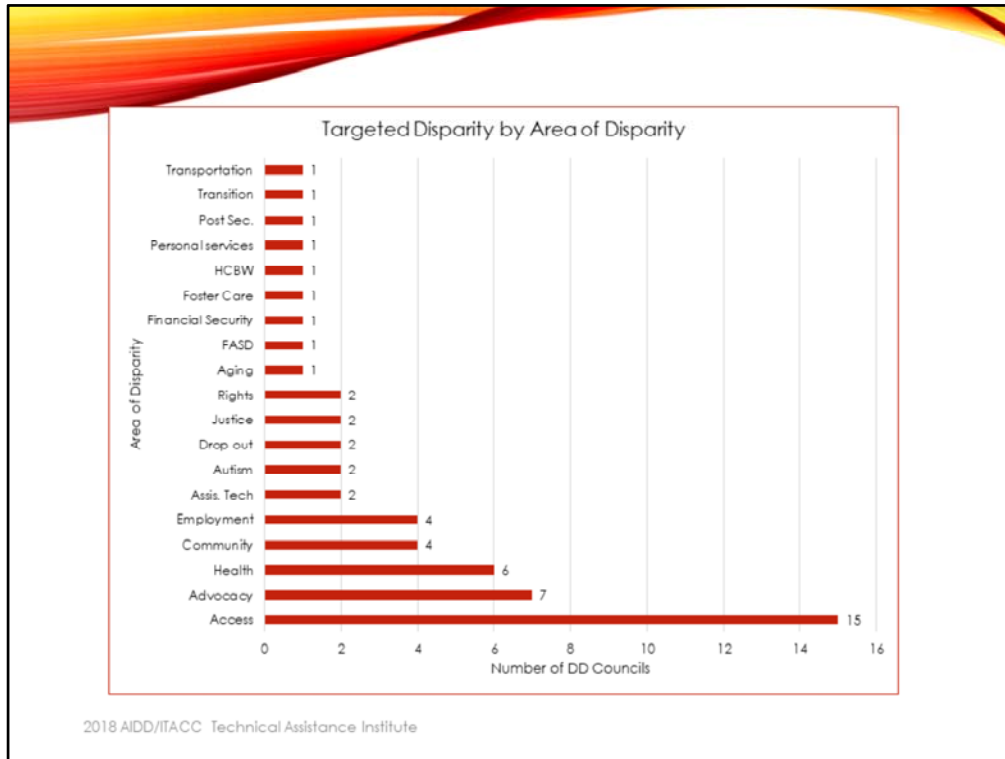
