

Results from 2018 Brief Technical Assistance (TA) Needs Assessment

Background

A brief technical assistance needs assessment was conducted during the 2018 AIDD Technical Assistance Institute. A total of 51 surveys were returned (38 at the TAI and 13 via Survey Monkey). The following results were obtained.

Results

Each item on the survey was ranked as a high need, moderate need, low need, or no need.

Three areas were prioritized for ranking and included fiscal, state plan, and program performance report.

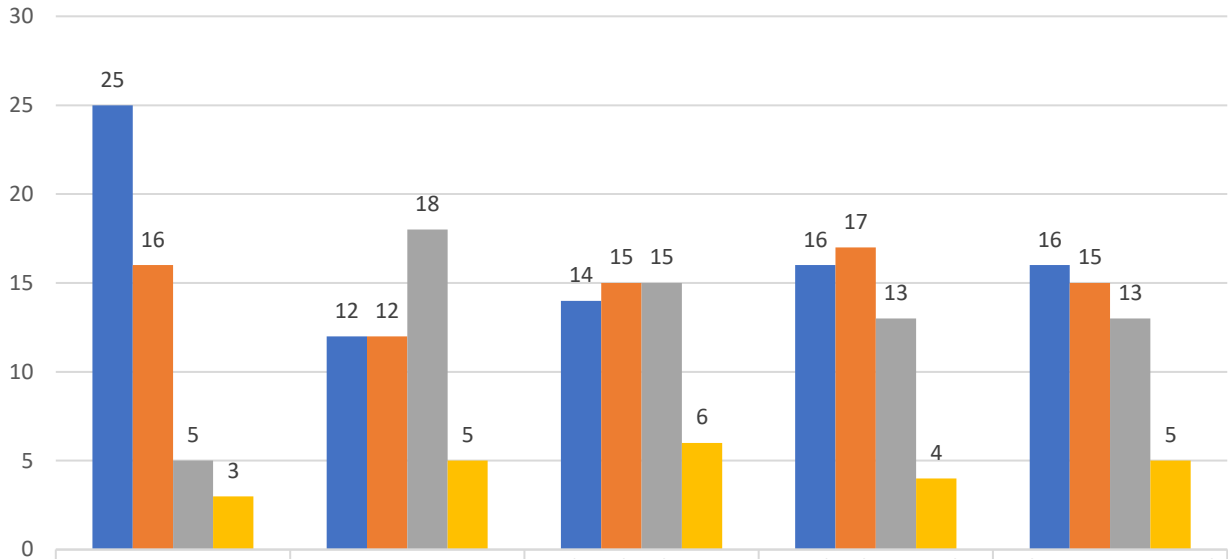
Based on the responses, the following topics were identified as high/moderate need listed in order of most need.

- 1) Obligation/liquidation of federal funds
- 2) Program Performance Report Analysis
- 3) Program Performance Report Development
- 4) Council and AIDD Performance Measures
- 5) Annual Work Plan Development and Updates
- 6) Federal financial reports
- 7) Targeted disparity
- 8) Subrecipient management and monitoring
- 9) Self-advocacy goal/objective
- 10) DD Network Collaboration
- 11) Match
- 12) State plan Updates/amendments
- 13) State plan – Monitoring progress
- 14) Budget development and implementation

Next steps

These results will be used to inform a broader needs assessment to be conducted before the end of the fiscal year and guide technical assistance efforts on immediate needs for the Council Network.

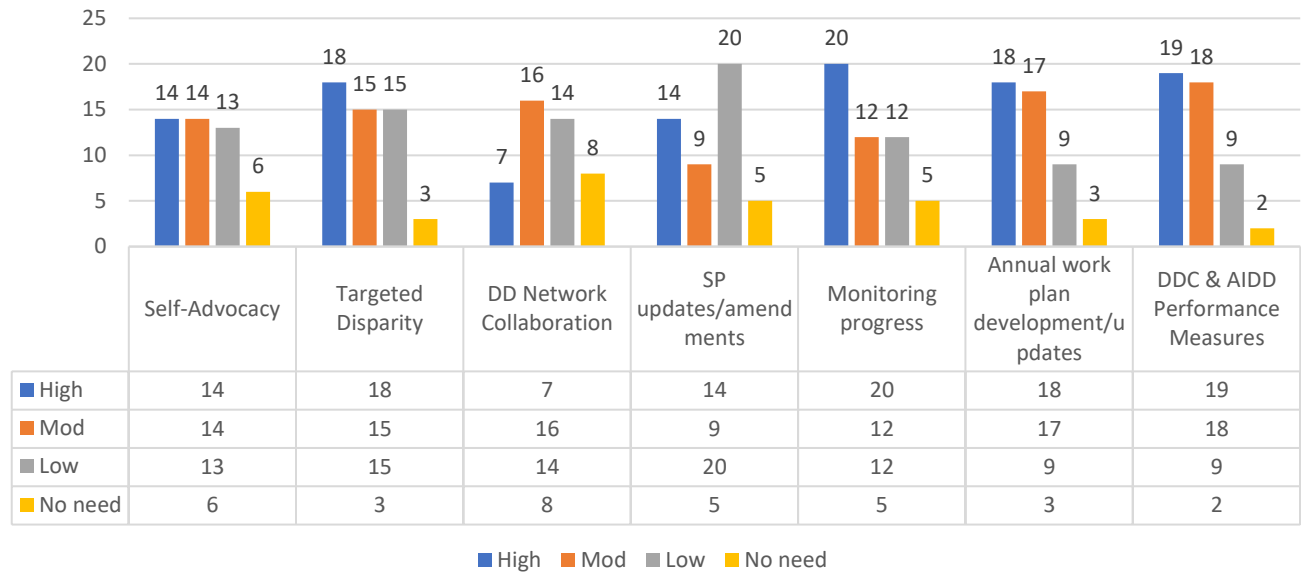
